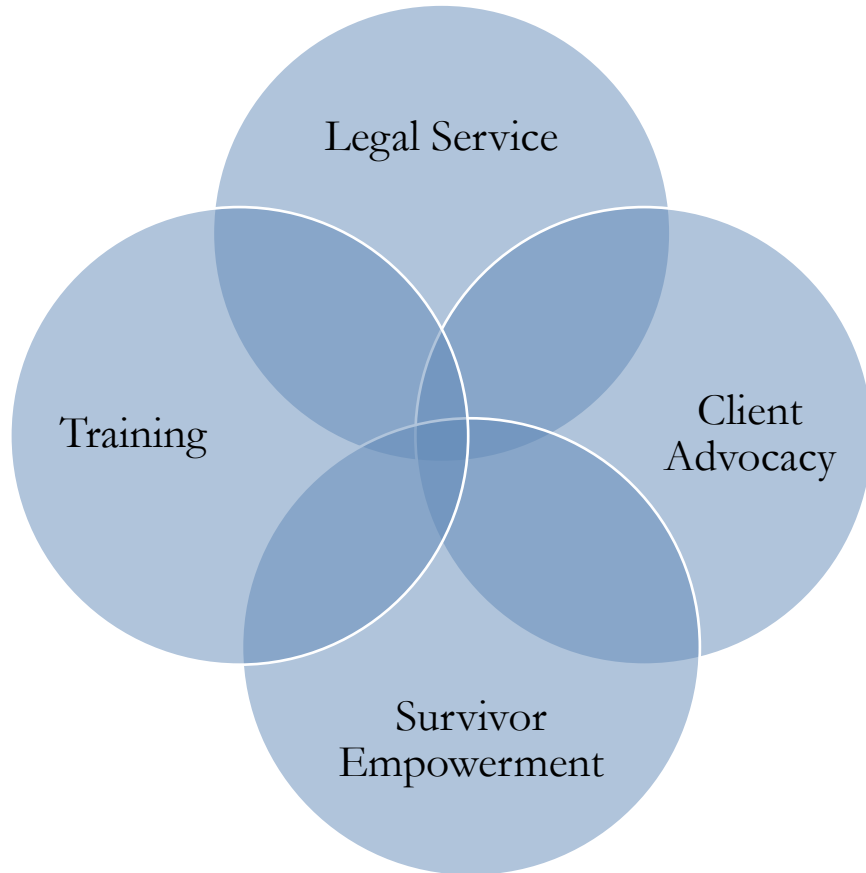

- Our goal is to meet the individualized needs of victims/survivors by offering life skills and career development opportunities.

## Highlights of our services include:

- ✓ Assessment of skills and abilities
- ✓ Development of personal, educational and career goals with an eye toward achieving family-sustaining employment. This includes facilitated work experience and/or short-term, skill-specific training, when appropriate.
- ✓ Life Coaching and case management
- ✓ Resource development to address barriers to success
- ✓ Career Navigation
- ✓ Soft skills training and coaching
- ✓ Upskilling and reskilling through skill-specific credentialing
- ✓ Training on basic skills
- ✓ Digital literacy
- ✓ Financial literacy
- ✓ Career Online High School
- ✓ Workforce credentialing – through referrals or vouchers
- ✓ Volunteer/internship opportunities
- ✓ Job placement and ongoing follow-up and follow-along
